



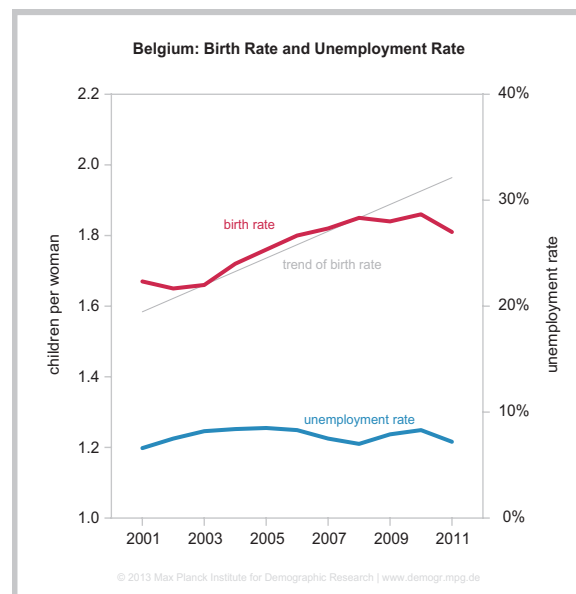
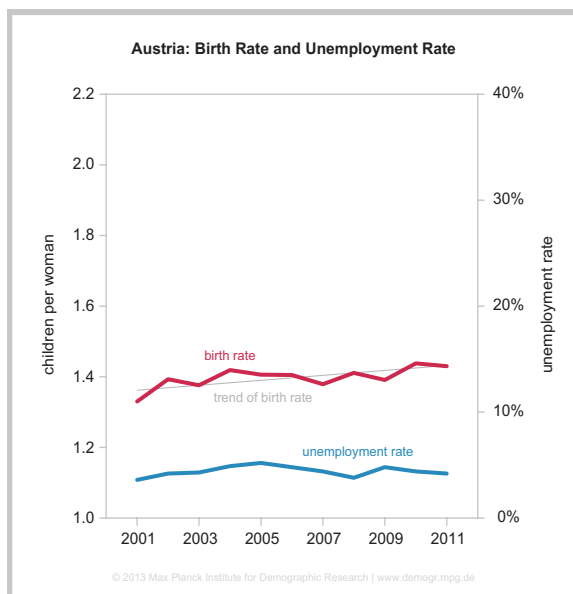

## Graphs of birth rates and unemployment rates for 28 European countries

The following 28 graphs depict the birth rates (total fertility rates) and unemployment rates for 28 European countries from 2001 to 2011 (for some countries there's no data for individual years).

On average, the more the unemployment rose, the greater the decrease in fertility compared to the number of children per women expected without the crisis (see press release "Economic crisis lowers birth rates").
